I am reaching out to you with enthusiasm and determination to express my desire to participate in the Working Holiday Visa program in Japan. My experience and plans align with the opportunity to immerse myself more deeply in Japanese culture.

Graduated with a dual French-Japanese Bachelor, after sixteen months of study and travel in Japan, via Beppu, Tokyo, Osaka, as well as Fukuoka and Okinawa, I truly realize the richness of Japanese culture and what it holds. Each new city, and new landscape that I discovered comforted me in the idea of continuing to explore this wonderful land. I perceived the spirit of Japan, still, I am more than determined to dive into its soul, to admire Mount Fuji and to explore other impressive mountains, to recharge in its natural landscapes and lively cities.

As a personal challenge and to support my explorations, I am looking for part-time jobs, part-time work to be occupied from 2 to 3 months, in the restoration, coffee shops, and hoteliers, as well as teaching, via already established relations and diverse platforms provided for this purpose. I also have artistic aspirations, and Japan has been able to open new perspectives and a new breath of inspiration, which motivates me to pursue various projects.

This working holiday visa program represents a unique chance to immerse myself deeper in Japanese culture, learn, grow, and contribute positively to the local community. I am ready to embark on this adventure and to respect the rules and values of the program. Japan represents so many lessons that I only grow from, an intense passion that I have explored too little. The lands of the rising sun inspire me to become a better person, both on a personal level and in the development of my future projects.
