<p>Période</p> <p><b>Part 1:</b> September 2023 – February 2024</p>	<p>Villes dans lesquelles vous comptez séjourner. Type d'hébergement et loyer envisagé.</p> <p><b>City :</b> Beppu, to enjoy all Kyushu area.</p> <p><b>Type of accommodation:</b> Roommate with a student at Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University ルーミング別府 8-46, Ishigakihigashi 1-Chôme Beppu, Oita Japon 874-0919</p> <p><b>Rent:</b> Between 30,000 Yen/month and 35,000 Yen/month, depending on additional charges such as electricity. The rent cost has already been agreed upon with the roommate in question.</p> <p>I intend to primarily reside in Beppu during this initial period. Most of the destinations I have in mind are for short trips can be covered within one or two days. Moving in with no additional costs except rent. I already have a Japanese phone number and a bank account (Japan Post) from my last stay. I am already familiar with this region and confident in my ability to move easily. Sakura mobile: about 4,000 yen per month</p> <p><b>Employment:</b> → Seeking part-time jobs (restaurant, waiter, cleaning...) in Beppu with an hourly wage of 850 yen, between 14-20 hours per week. (47,600 yen/month; 68,000 yen/month) → Teaching English online in Oita and Beppu through Hello Sensei (between 1,000 and 1,500 yen per hour). Not so many students are willing to take lessons in this area, so it might be occasional. But it is a great manner to meet with people.</p> <p><b>Options for part time job:</b> → McDonald's, Starbucks, hotels (Suginoi, Kamenoi, Sekinoi...), local restaurants, and coffee shops are places that recruit mostly in Beppu. → If possible, gathering information on modeling agencies (SOS Model Agency, Tomorrow models...) for the second part of the stay in Japan.</p> <p><b>Places I want to visit:</b> - <u>Beppu</u> (Onsen, Beppu's Hell...) =&gt; city I plan to live in  - <u>Kitakyushu</u> (Kokura Castle, visit the town. However, Kawachi Wisteria Garden might be closed at this time of the year) =&gt; can be one day trip, accessible by car (about 3,000 yen if two travelers) or by train (around 6,000 yen round trip)  - <u>Fukuoka</u> (enjoy the animation of Fukuoka) =&gt; two day trip. Can be accessible by car or Bus (from 5,000 yen) + hotel/Airbnb (around 3,000 yen)  - <u>Yufuin</u> (I want to climb Yufu-dake) =&gt; bus from Beppu up to 3,000 yen go and back. 1 day trip.  - <u>Kumamoto</u> (visit Sakuranobaba, parcs and Museum) =&gt; two day trip. By car (3000 yen per person if two travelers) By train (6,000 yen or more round trip), Hotel/Airbnb (3,000 yen)  - <u>Takachiho</u> (Takachiho gorge in Miyazaki, boating in the river, visit Amaterasu's temple) =&gt; 1 day trip, accessible by car, cost shared. Discover all the corners of Tokyo’s area, especially those a little more hidden). =&gt; Use a normal IC card (suica) to visit Tokyo, and hike inside Tokyo.</p> <p>-Try Disneyland and Disney Sea (up to 10,000 yen)</p> <p>-Explore the surroundings of Tokyo: <u>Nishi Tokyo</u> (parks, temples, Toshimaya Shuzo, Tanashi tour...); <u>Hachioji</u> (can be a 2-days trip: Museum, temples, castle, Mount Takao); <u>Mitaka</u> (Ghibli museum, Inokashira park, Reversible Destiny Lofts Mitaka, and must-go places); hike in <u>Okutama</u> and discover the wonderful landscapes (can be 2-days trip); <u>Machida</u> and meet with squirrels; <u>Hakone</u>... =&gt; these destinations are close to Tokyo and accessible by train for affordable price.</p> <p>-<u>Mount Fuji</u> ascension in spring (from June only), 2-3 days =&gt; accessible by train (up to 10,000 yen round trip)</p> <p>-Take 1 week to visit <u>Osaka, Kyoto, Kobe, Nara</u>. =&gt; Train/plane depending on the price (+/- 20,000 yen roundtrip)</p> <p>-3-4 days trip in Nagoya =&gt;by train (+/-20,000 yen round trip)</p> <p><b>Potential employment:</b> -&gt;Look for baito 14 - 20 hours per week with hourly wage of about 950 yen (minimum in Tokyo).
